

The Young Dancer Experience

Intro to Dance, Dance 1, New Dancer Intro, Hip Hop 1, Hip Hop 2, DAA Crew and Dance 2

Dancing Arts Academy is ready for a show like no other! Our dancers are ready to shine onstage!

To maximize the experience for our dance families, we are having two separate performances this year. Many of our younger dancers will be placed in Act 1 which will begin at 5:30, and will have the option to leave at intermission or sit and watch the rest of the show with their grown ups. Our older dancers will all be placed in Acts 2 or 3, which will begin at 7pm. We will manage ticket sales and seating accordingly to ensure fair access for audience members of both shows.

Our younger dancers are invited to a walk-through tour of our recital venue at **6 pm on Thursday June 9th**. They won't be practicing their dance onstage and they won't need to wear their costumes/hair/makeup to this walk-through. We will show them around the new place see the stage and dressing rooms, and get familiar with the surroundings. Then we will rehearse the finale and curtain call for Act 1.

On **Wednesday evening** we will have a studio rehearsal in costume for these Act 1 dancers. This will be in conjunction with an awesome opportunity to have your dancers' pictures taken by Raske Photography. A digital photography package will be available for sale, and time slots will be limited.



DRESS REHEARSAL Thursday June 9th, 2022 4:00pm – 8:00pm at the McCarthy Middle School

- Certain recital routines will be rehearsed on stage in full costume. The following Tuesday guidelines ONLY apply to the dances listed under mandatory DRESS REHEARSAL on the previous page of the packet.
- Parents may stay at the dress rehearsal, but be prepared to stay in your designated area.
- We will rehearse the Curtain Call at 5:30 and give announcements, so please be present. The Curtain Call is the finale of the show when all dancers take their bow.
 Be ready!
- D Please inform Jackie by email if your dancer has a conflict.
- Please aim to arrive fifteen minutes before the rehearsal to check in. It helps us stay on schedule when everyone is prepared. Send your dancer with a water bottle and snack.
- Please remember to bring all of your costume pieces and accessories to the rehearsal. Even our older students need your support to feel confident, so please help them consult their costume info sheets ahead of time and organize their belongings. It's important to practice on stage in costume!
- Recital staff will be available throughout the afternoon to address questions regarding the rehearsal and performance. Any remaining tickets and t-shirts will be on sale.
- This dress rehearsal will be a great opportunity to take pictures and videos! Please, no cameras during the actual recital performance.

RECITAL DAY INFORMATION

- Dancers should arrive in their first costume, wearing their street shoes.
 Dance shoes should only be worn onstage.
- The recital order is on the second page of this packet! Go through it with your dancer and identify their routines. This will help our dancers organize their belongings.
- We highly recommend purchasing your tickets before the recital to allow for the best experience for everyone.
- Please, no phones, cameras, or recording devices during the recital performance. This is proper theater etiquette as well as a security issue.
- Young Dancer's will be dismissed to a grown up during the first intermission. Please consider staying to support the older dancers!
- Please have your dancers hair and makeup done before arrival.
 Parents will not be allowed in the dressing area.
- Concessions and merchandise will be on sale accepting cash, Venmo, or Paypal.
- □ Students in ACT 1 should arrive between 5:00 and 5:15. The house will open at 5:15.
- Dancers in ACT 2 or 3 should arrive between 6:15-6:30. The house will open for new seating at 6:45.



BACKSTAGE GUIDELINES

- Recital Staff will be on hand to sign in dancers prior to the performance and direct them to the rest of their class. During the performance dancers will be backstage and we encourage family members to remain in the audience to support the other dancers until the end of the recital. Dancers will not be allowed in the audience area during the show itself. When you check your dancer in for the recital, make sure they have everything they'll need.
- Do your dancer's hair and makeup at home please, and bring them dressed in their costume and ready to go! Our experienced Recital Staff will be on hand to take care of all hair, makeup, and costume needs throughout the day after students are checked in, but should not be working from scratch during the busy prep time before the show.
- Please clearly label all of your costume pieces and accessories and be prepared to leave them with your dancer upon sign in. Water only will be allowed in the dressing room, no food. Make sure your dancer has breakfast and lunch before the show!

SHOES AND TIGHTS

- All students will need the correct footwear discussed in class for the recital.
 Tights are in stock at Damien's Dancewear in North Chelmsford. Ask for
 Capezio or Body Wrappers tights in the color listed in your costume info sheet.
 It's very important that all students have the same color and brand of tights.
- Each class has received a detailed Costume Info Sheet that pertains specifically to their class and costume. This will cover recommended hair styles, makeup colors, footwear, and any accessories that come with the costume. Once you get your flyer, please let me know if you have any questions, so you can be as prepared as possible for rehearsal and recital.
- Label all shoes with the students name or initials so there is no confusion backstage.
- Tights MAY be on sale at the studio for \$10- each! We have some inventory leftover from last season. Email with your size and color request.
